Executive summary
This paper provides Moorfields response to issues raised by NHS England following the verdict of the trial of Lucy Letby. The NHS England letter is attached.

Quality implications
The NHS England letter raises a number of aspects of quality and corporate governance that Moorfields has responded positively to, highlighting where progress has been made and/or where further actions are in progress. This includes improving Freedom to Speak Up arrangements, strengthening our approach to patient safety through implementation of the new patient safety incident response framework (PSIRF), ensuring that Moorfields is included in the role of the Medical Examiner, ensuring the new fit and proper person’s test framework is introduced at Moorfields, and embedding the updated paediatric early warning scores criteria. Moorfields responds to each of the points within this paper.

Financial implications
There are no additional financial resource implications of this paper.

Risk implications
Moorfields stands alongside NHS England to do everything possible to prevent anything like this happening again, particularly through strengthening patient safety monitoring, and providing a safe environment for staff to be able raise concerns and to act on those.
